6. Progress in Rehabilitation Medicine (PRM) is JARM's official English journal.

To obtain the impact factor for PRM, we have applied to the listing examination for the Emerging Sources Citation Index, launched by Clarivate Analytics. We have also created our official account on Twitter to promote PR activities, sharing PRM publications widely. Note that now PRM has been listed in the EBSCOhost databases, a worldwide online research platform. 64 papers were published in 2022.
